



Kita Kaze Fee list for 2009/10

- **Monthly dues**

This is your **monthly** club membership fee is \$40 and covers your training at regular classes, twice per week. If there are two or more in the same family training in the club, the fee is \$35 per month per student. If you tell your instructor well ahead of time that you cannot be at training for an extended period or can only drop in occasionally, the fee will be \$10 per class. If you pay your monthly fee and simply do not show up, the fees are non-refundable. We assume that, if you paid your fees, you are coming. We have to arrange for instructors to be here to teach you and that is partly what your fees are for.

If you wish to pay for the year in advance, the rate is \$300 (September through end of May).

If you have two or more family members in the club, the rate is \$250 for the year per person.

- **Kobudo/Iaido**

If you are practicing kobudo, there is a \$20 monthly fee. If you are practicing iaido, there is a \$20 monthly fee. If you are practicing both, the total fee is \$30 monthly.

- **Brown and Black Belt Training**

If you are training in the afternoon B&B class, there is a \$20 per month fee.

- **ShotoCanada**

ShotoCanada is our parent karate group that gives us our technical guidance. Annual dues are \$20 juniors and \$30 adults. These fees are due once per year in **September**. For beginners, they are required when you join the regular club.

- **Insurance \$30**

- **syllabus**

There is a one time \$10 administration fee for the syllabus. For that, we give you the password to the website where you can download it and print it out.

- **grading**

Every time you test for a belt, there is a \$15 fee, pass or not. If you receive a new belt, there is an additional \$10 fee. There is a separate fee range for brown and black belts.

Equipment

- **gi** this is the uniform you wear. A beginner's gi will cost \$35 to \$50 depending on size and shipping costs.
- **Protective gear** all males require a groin protector. We can order cups designed for karate for about \$20.
- Wearing a chest and groin protector is optional for women.
- After about a year's training, you will require fitted teeth protectors and sparring gloves. You can have the teeth protectors fitted at a dental clinic or you can use the guards that you soak in hot water and mould to your teeth. We will order the sparring gloves for you. They cost about \$25.

A child joining the regular club following a beginners' course would have the following fees for the first full month of training:
